

## **COUNCILLOR VACANCIES – NETHERBURY PARISH COUNCIL**

Following the recent May elections, two vacancies exist on Netherbury Parish Council.

To be eligible to take a seat on the Parish Council you must meet one of the criteria set out in the Local Government Act 1972 section 79 and 80:

- you are on the parish council electoral register; or
- you have resided in the parish for the past twelve months or rented / tenanted land in the parish; or
- your principal place of work is in the parish; or
- you live within three miles (direct) of the parish

Do you care about your local community and have time to commit to the role? If so, then Netherbury Parish Council would like to hear from you. The Parish Council are particularly looking for councillors to represent the areas of Waytown / Oxbridge and Salway Ash.
