

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DRURY LANE, NETHERBURY

DORSET COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along DRURY LANE, NETHERBURY between Crook Hill and Waterpot Hill (in both directions) a distance of approximately 800 metres. The Notice is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to highway users.

It came in to operation on 1 July 2021 and can remain in force for up to 21 days, however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 July 2021.

This Notice will enable Wessex Water safe access to carry out emergency works to repair a burst rising main.

The alternative route, which will be sign posted is as follows: Crook Hill - Waterpot Hill
