

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PINEAPPLE LANE, SALWAY ASH

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along PINEAPPLE LANE, SALWAY ASH, at the river crossing, a distance of approximately 20 metres. The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users. It will come into operation on 30 September 2019 and remain in force for 18 months however it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 November 2019. This Order can be extended with approval of the Secretary of State.

This Order will enable Dorset Council to carry out concrete repairs and possible saddling to bridge.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed sections.
